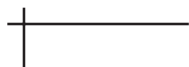

Brief Annotations

Dermatovenereological Outpatient Care

(denotation: ZŠ-23/2004)



Statistical data are processed based on the *Annual Report on Activity of Dermatovenereological Outpatient Departments*. The publication contains data on activity of dermatovenereological outpatient departments, number of registered and newly reported patients of dermatovenereological diseases by the end of following year according to selected diagnoses. Published data are for the Slovak Republic and regions.

Outpatient Care of Children and Adolescents

(denotation: ZŠ-26/2004)



Statistical data are processed based on the *Annual Report on Activity of Outpatient Departments for Children and Adolescents*. The publication contains data on types of examinations/treatments of children and adolescents, on number of diseases in follow-up children and adolescents according to main groups of ICD-10 in the SR and particular regions and on activity of specialised paediatric outpatient departments.

Outpatient Care - Tuberculosis and Respiratory Diseases

(denotation: ZŠ-21/2004)



Statistical data are processed based on the *Annual Report on Activity of Outpatient Departments for TB and Respiratory Diseases*. It contains data on the number of patients registered of TB, registered non-tuberculosis diseases of respiratory system, newly determined cases, recurrence and deaths due to TB, results of X-ray screening and trend series of selected indicators for years 1985 – 2003.

Anaesthesiological and Resuscitative Activity

(denotation: ZŠ-34/2004)



Statistical data are processed based on the *Annual Report on Anaesthesiological and Resuscitative Activity*. The publication contains data on the number of departments, outpatient departments and beds in anaesthesiological-resuscitative departments and on categories of staff. It also provides data on anaesthesiological and intensive care and trend series of selected indicators.

Activity of Diabetological Outpatient Departments

(denotation: ZŠ-11/2004)



Statistical data are processed based on the *Annual Report on Activities of Diabetological Outpatient Departments*. The publication provides statistical data on activities of diabetological outpatient departments, number and age structure of diabetics registered, duration of illness, number of examinations and structure of treatment. Further, it contains trend series of selected indicators since 1980.

Activity of Clinical Oncology Departments

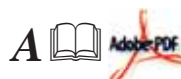
(denotation: ZŠ-46/2004)



Statistical data are processed based on the *Annual Report on Activity of Department and Clinical Oncology Outpatient Department*. The publication contains processed statistical data on structure of work places and working posts in departments and clinical oncology outpatient departments, on the number of patients and examinations, data on treatment and pharmaceuticals-related expenditures. Publication is supplemented with trend in incidence and mortality in the most frequent tumoral diseases.

Drug Addiction – Drug User Treatment

(denotation: ZŠ-44/2004)



Statistical data are processed based on the *Report of Drug User Treatment*. The publication contains data on addicted clients of illicit addictive drugs, who were under cure with impact on their psychological, medical and social state and who look for help for their drug addiction problems. Data are classified according to using primary drug, sex, age groups, way of administration and territory distribution of provider treatment to drug user and permanent address of client.

Occupational Diseases or Occupational Disease Threats

(denotation: ZŠ-6/2004)



Statistical data are processed based on the *Report on Occupational Disease or Occupational Disease Threats*. The publication informs on incidence and reported occupational diseases development according to sex, age groups, chapters of the branch classification of economic activities and professions.

Balneological Care
(denotation: ZŠ-8/2004)



Statistical data are processed based on the *Report on Terminated Balneological Treatment*. The publication contains data on the number of patients treated in natural health resorts (nationals, foreigners) Data are classified according to indication list for balneological care, way of stay payment, treatment result, sex and economic activity.

Nephrological Care and Medical Cure Substituting Function of Kidney (denotation: ZŠ-31/2004)



Publication substituted health statistics Activity of Dialysis in the SR, Nephrological Care of Adults – Outpatient Care in the SR and Nephrological Outpatient Care of Children in the SR issuing until 1990. Statistical data are processed based on the *Annual Report on Nephrological Care and Medical Treatment Substituting Function of Kidney*. The publication contains data on personal and technical assurance of work places, on followed-up patients with risk factors, on procedures of dialysis cure and on activities of nephrological stations.

Urgent Surgery in Certain Diseases
(denotation: ZŠ-10/2004)



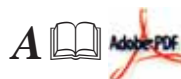
Statistical data are processed based on the *Annual Report on Urgent Surgery Intervention in Certain Diseases*. The publication provides statistical data on the number of urgent surgery interventions in selected diseases. It also contains time data when operations were carried out from patient's hospital admission and trends in the number of urgent surgery interventions in selected diseases since 1985.

Sexual transmitted Diseases
(denotation: ZŠ-1/2004)



Statistical data are processed based on the *Report on STD*. This publication contains an information on STD and according to the type of disease (the first occurrence in life, recurrence, reinfection, recognised at death and chronic), according to sex, age groups, marital status, economic activity, diagnosis, territorial distribution of patient's residence and on reported diseases according to medical establishments.

Abortions
(denotation: ZŠ-7/2004)



Statistical data are processed based on the *Application for Induced Abortion and Report on Abortion*. The publication presents data on the number of abortions according to type of abortion, number of live born children prior to the abortion, age and weight of the foetus, age group, marital status, education level, territorial distribution of female residence and territorial distribution of place of abortion report.

Psychiatric Care
(denotation: ZŠ-4/2004)



Publication substituted publications Psychiatric Care in the SR and Outpatient Care – Psychiatric in the SR. Statistical data are processed based on the *Statistical Card of Patient Admitted to Psychiatric Establishment, Annual Report on Activities of Hospital Psychiatric Department, Psychiatric Hospital and Psychiatric Medical Institution* and *Annual Report on Activities of Psychiatric Outpatient Departments*. The publication contains data on the psychiatric health establishments' network, number of examinations and medical treatments, number of physician posts, beds fund. The publication also contains overview of professional activity in psychiatric outpatient departments and registered patients according to diagnoses, sex and age groups. It provides additional data on patients admitted to psychiatric health facilities, which are divided according to sex, age groups, groups of psychiatric diagnoses, length of hospitalization, education level and economic activity.

Suicides and Suicide Attempts
(denotation: ZŠ-5/2004)



Statistical data are processed based on the *Report on Causes and Circumstances of Intentional Self-injury*. The publication contains data on type of intentional self-injury, mode of its realisation, groups of psychiatric diagnoses, motive of act, place and time of realisation, classified by sex, age groups, marital status, education level, economic activity, territorial distribution of residence and place of intentional self-injury report.

Common diagnostic and curative elements
(denotation: ZŠ-48/2004)



The publication substitutes since 2000 till that time issued publications *Activities of Clinical Biochemistry Departments, Activities of Nuclear Medicine Departments, Activities of Physiatriac-rehabilitative Departments, Activities of Radiodiagnostical Departments, Activities of Haematological and Transfusional Departments and Activities of Pathological Departments*. Statistical data are processed based on the *Annual Report on Activity of Clinical Biochemistry Department and Outpatient Department, Annual Report on Activities of Nuclear Medicine Department (working-place), Annual Report on Activities of Physiatrics-rehabilitative (rehabilitative) Department and Outpatient Department, Annual Report on Activities of Radiodiagnostical Department and Outpatient Department, Annual Report on Activities of Haematological and Transfusional Department (division), Annual Report on Activities of Pathology*.

Publication contains:

- data on structure of examinations and working positions
- data on number of patients and particular types of examinations
- data on number of registered patients and their distribution according to type of diagnosis and classification groups

Care of Female
(denotation: ZŠ-14/2004)



Since 2000, it substituted till that time issued publications Activity of Gynaecological Outpatient Departments in the Slovak Republic and Gynaecological – Obstetric care in the Slovak Republic. Statistical data are processed based on the *Annual Report on Gynaecological-Obstetric Care* and *Annual Report on Activity of Gynaecology Outpatient Departments*. The publication provides statistical data on the number and type of gynaecological examinations, number and types of examination methods, information on contraception using in females. Further, it provides statistical data on number of deliveries and types of obstetric operations and other indicators of obstetric care. The publication presents development series of selected indicators since 1985.

Stomatology Care
(denotation: ZŠ-15 /2004)



Publication presents results of the *Annual Report on Stomatology Care processing*. It contains data on number of examinations, provided types of services in stomatology outpatient departments, and informs on systematic care of dentition of children and adolescents.

Paramedical Schools in School Year 2003/2004
(denotation: ZŠ-12 /2004)



Statistical data are processed based on the *Report of Grammar School-Secondary Special School- Conservatory and Report on Boarding Houses*. Publication contains data on public and ecclesiastic paramedical schools, on development in full-time study, extramural study, on number of schools, classes, graduates, teachers, study specialisations in the SR and regions. Further, it provides data on number of boarding houses, bed capacity, accommodated pupils and educators.

Statistics on Hospitalised Patients
(denotation: ZŠ-25/2004)



Statistical data are processed based on the *Record on Hospitalisation*. The publication contains basic statistical data on demography, the number of beds, number of hospitalised persons and on death causes, which the most shared in the total mortality in the SR. Publication issues in this structure since 1987. Even statistics publications of hospitalised patients are available already since 1966 (they contain only data on hospitalisations of discharged patients).

Temporary Incapacity to Work – due to disease and accident – Terminated Cases (denotation: ZŠ-2/2004)



Statistical data are processed based on the *Voucher of Temporary Incapacity to Work (I. Report for social insurance company – branch office)*. The total number of all terminated cases of the incapacity to work due to illness or injury is included to the evaluation. The publication contains overviews of the basic indicators on terminated cases of incapacity to work by the groups of diagnoses, sex and age groups.

Congenital Disorders
(denotation: ZŠ-3/2004)



Statistical data are processed based on the *Report on Congenital Disorder*. The publication contains data on live births and stillbirths with congenital disorder, on legally induced abortions for the reason of the prenatal detection of congenital disorder of foetus. Data are classified by diagnoses of congenital disorders, sex of child (foetus) as well as his/her weight and length, gestation age of foetus, parents' age, and the territorial distribution of mother's residence.

Other Publications

Health Statistics Yearbook of the Slovak Republic



The Institute of Health Information and Statistics still publishes the yearbook that is the continuation of the information given during previous years. Health Statistics Yearbook contains data of the Institute of Health Information and Statistics Bratislava, the Statistic Office of the Slovak Republic, the National Institute of Public Health Banská Bystrica, the Institute of TB, Respiratory Disease and Thoracal Surgery Vyšné Hágy, the Social Insurance Office, the National Oncologic Institute Bratislava, the Institute of Information and educational system prognoses Bratislava and the World Health Organisation.

The yearbook represents a sectional publication concerning the Slovak Republic and its regions for year 2003. It divides into the following chapters:

1. Demography
2. Health Status of the Population
3. Network and Activity of Health Establishments
4. Manpower and Health Educational System
5. Economic Indicators
6. International comparison
7. Enclosures.

It contains comprehensive overview of health organisations in the SR according to particular branches of activity with publishing identification data per health facility.

Analysis of evolution standardised mortality of circulatory system diseases in the Slovak Republic.



The Institute of Health Information and Statistics issued this publication based on fact that the highest mortality of inhabitants in a long-range is due to diseases of circulatory system. The publication is divided into six chapters and each chapter is divided into four main parts:

- Total mortality and mortality of circulatory system diseases (CSD) in the Slovak Republic for years 1970-1999,
- Evaluation of three main groups of diagnoses within CSD for years 1970 – 1999, which are divided into pre-productive, productive and post-productive age,
- Comparison of the Slovak Republic indicators in three main groups diagnoses within CSD for years 1997-1999 which are divided into pre-productive, productive and post-productive age with data for regions and districts,
- Comparison statistic data of the Slovak Republic with selected countries of Europe.

Select information on mortality development of the most frequent death causes in Slovak Republic within years 1971 – 2000



The publication presents trend in mortality in respective groups of diseases in the SR for years 1971 – 2000 including their comparison at districts level within years 1997 – 2000. Even development comparison with selected countries of Europe is part of publication in addition to basic demography information. Publication was carried out within project MONIKA in 2003.

We prepare:

Trend in Health Status of Population in Slovakia and in Czech

Publication presents trend comparison in basic demography indicators and health status of population in Slovakia and in Czech for years 1994 – 2002. We prepare it in co-operation with the Institute of Health Information and Statistics of the Czech Republic.

Economic Indicators of Health Facilities

We carry out publication through available economic data of the Institute of Health Information and Statistics. It contains data on expenditures and profits of health facilities. Publication issues in edition Health Statistics.

Prevalence in Selected Risk Factors of Health in Population of the Slovak Republic

Publication provides data on prevalence in selected risk factors of health of circulatory system diseases in age group 15 – 64 of respondents (random selection) of eight model districts of project MONIKA (IHIS) and CINDI (the Regional Office of Public Health Service Banská Bystrica, the Office of Public Health Service Trebišov) in 2002/2003. Project results are outbalanced per members of the same age group in population of the SR in ten years age intervals.

Selected Information of Health Statistics on Development in Circulatory System Diseases

Publication provides more comprehensive information on mortality and morbidity of circulatory system diseases in the SR for last decade including comparison of trend in selected indicators in the SR with countries of Europe.

Selected Information on Mortality and Morbidity of Tumours in the SR till 2000

Publication provides more complex view at development in mortality incidence of selected groups of tumours in the SR for years 1971 – 2000 (incidence) or 1971 – 2002 (mortality) including comparison of trend in selected indicators in the SR with countries of Europe. Publication was carried out thanks to co-operation with National Oncology Register.
